At DIIT, students are taught communication and interpersonal skills to enable them to interact effectively in the workforce.

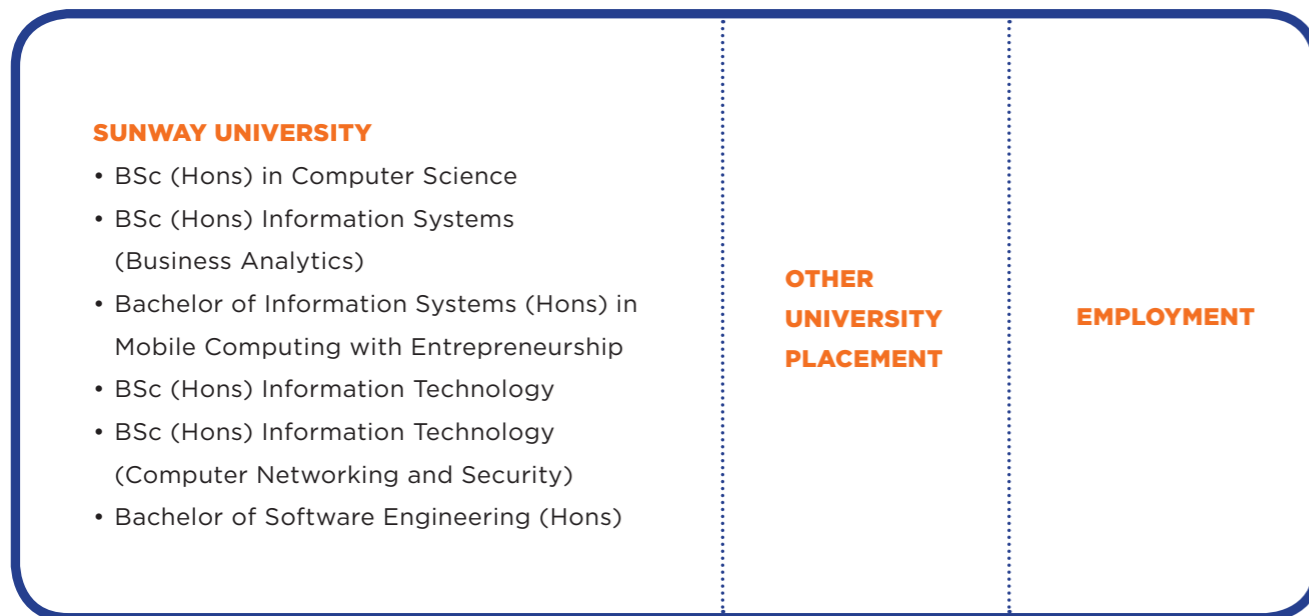
